CHAPTER THREE

However, for now show love to your parents and don’t hurt them. You cannot cut your nose to smite your face. It’s your won skin. Anthy Brandt cited in Maxwell (2001:140) reminded as that, “Other things may change us, but we start and end with family.

I shall survive the storms. In times of hatred or love the Lord will preserve me and the silver lining will be at the end of the tunnel (Anonymous).

INTRODUCTION

One time the late president Ronald Reagan of the United States of America said “after the storms the stars will appear. This was in the 1980’s after a tragedy hit the US of course not the 11th September 2002 disaster and a pilot was taken captive in a foreign land and Reverend Jesse Jackson went to negotiate for his release and succeeded. The pilot survived. It takes someone to fight for our release and this He did willingly and day in and day out, we bear these marks, on our bodies. A rare feat in all religious settings.

Many times the devil tempts us sore.

Winds blow as if they are gales or hurricanes. Disappointments, failures, soul-wretchedness, are felt in the midst of plenty. Life seems unpleasant and the cool air becomes hot and you feel warm. When nobody is sweating, you are, whereas you’re not in your menopause or andropause too. Young man, young woman, old and aged, life sometimes tosses us about. Loved ones pretend as if they care. Hatred, sorrows, afflictions pave your way and life seems meaningless. The unexpected happens and your lips are pursed and you cannot utter a word and you have a deep breath and you ask yourself “Can I survive?” Can I survive this? Friends, there is nothing in this world that you cannot survive it. The Bible says “*All things are possible to him that believes*” (Matthew 19:26) **All things.** Survival in the midst of misfortune, when rejected, when treated as a fool and when neglected. But you are a royal, a royal priesthood, a peculiar nation

(I Peter 2:9), the child of the most High God. What is your affliction? Poverty, sickness, divorce, separation as a family man or woman or single parenting? As a young man or woman, are you afflicted because you haven’t got someone to marry? Have you been treated unfairly? Who did this? A suitor, a fiancé or a fiancée? Have you been cheated on, deprived of your properties that

you had rightfully owed through the genuine labour of your hands and you even feel like paying for it through hatred, anger or self pity?

Jesus the Rescuer

Who had ever suffered like this and God or Jesus Christ refused to adhere to a genuine prayer?

The Bible talks about the story of Peter the Apostle, and the brethren, the fishermen disciples who went to fishing with him (Luke 5:4-9). For a whole night they toiled but had no fish. Luke 5:5 says, if you have ever been with the fishermen, you'd notice that they have their own natural way of observing the moon and the tides to determine when and where to fish for bumper harvest in order to have something worth the labour. The bible says, Peter and his friends had nothing. You can imagine the toil of a wretched man going to do exploits. Probably, counting the number of chicks before the hen starts hatching the eggs. Peter and his brethren could have thought so, as you, and I are but there was no show. How many times haven't you given it a thought that "as for this time my visa would be given, as for this year, I would have started my building or moved out off the rented house?" But five times had elapsed and nothing happened. How many times have you recalled working that statistics on town planning, and the number of HIV/AIDS patients and family care and you got the computation wrong? Have you not been disappointed by a close friend to the extent that death was almost imminent? Who had not been disappointed before? Jesus Christ our Lord had similar experience when one of His followers Judas Iscariot turned the relationship sore till he hanged himself in shame. The question is "Didn't Jesus Christ know of Judas Iscariot's venomous plans?" Yes, of course, He who knows the beginning from the end. The biblical report (Isaiah 46:9) "for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me". verse: 10 Declaring the end from the beginning and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying my counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure (Isaiah 46:9-10). He foreknew Judas Iscariot's agenda but he never said it till one day he said "one of you will betray me". And all turned to ask "is it I?" and he said "But behold, the hand of him betrayeth me is with me on the table, (Luke 22:21). It is the one whose hands are in the same bowl with me. Soon after, He was caught and tried; ridiculed, despised, tortured and Jesus carried the cross for my sins.

But why carry another cross?

Jesus Christ the same yesterday, today and forever (Hebrews 13:8).

So the question is “why should Jesus Christ allow us to go through afflictions? Some of which are problems with damaged organs due to difficulty of blood flow to the brain like stroke – cerebral vascular accident; some are psychological resulting to psychiatric problems like madness of both young and old people. Why should this be so? Why should an innocent child become a psychiatric patient? Due to hereditary factor. Why should some children be abandoned, sexually defiled, physically tortured, amputated and starved of parental affection and food? Why should I suffer physically and emotionally having terrible shocks of my life? Why? The Bible Believer’s Hymnal 89 has this to say.

Must Jesus Bear Alone?

Must Jesus bear the cross alone.

And all the world go free?

No, there’s a cross for every one,

And there’s a cross for me.

Peter and friends at sea

If we look critically at the event at sea, in (Luke 5:4-8) when the apostles toiled and had nothing, we can see that they were by profession, fishermen, at least Peter, who had **professional knowledge about fishing. They toiled.** That represents hard work over a period and were **expecting** some catch. **There are basically five key words here; professional knowledge; fishing, toiled and expecting. Professional knowledge** signifies a job or an experience acquired over a long time of practice; it is a hands-on approach.

It is not something

It is not something told as a tale, but involved mastery of both theory and practicals of a specific discipline and in this case, it is fishing.

Nobody works hard without expectation of rewards.

There the natural law of cause and effect as in planting seeds and harvesting holds. There is seed time and harvest time. Input produces output. The magnitude of output is determined by the amount of input. Peter and friends were expecting nothing less than a bumper catch for the time

and every energy put in the work, because for a whole night they toiled. But the bible says they had “nothing”. This didn’t mean hope is lost though Satan might have been saying, “you’d trust in your God, and now you’re disappointed. And hasn’t this same Satan told you the same story many, many times when you experienced failures in chains as if light shines within seconds and darkness lingers for hours, days, months to years and you want to give up? If you had no “fish” there’s the tendency that you’d renounce him as the Lord. Although this is my own figment, as human as they were, it was possible that some might have had this thought and many diverse kinds. It was likely also that they believing in the Lord and trusting him had been meditating though sorrowful but never losing focus on the EVERLASTING ARM OF GOD on their lives. Man must eat, therefore he needs to survive. In Christ the Rock of Ages, you’d survive and I will survive the storms of life also. Lo! And behold as the apostles pondered over these, the rescue came. Jesus appeared on the scene. “Children have ye any meat?” They answered, “No, we toiled all night long and there was no effect”. The Master of the sea and all the minerals in the soil, the birds, trees, seas and rivers, all the highways and valleys including man are His own. He controls the weather and season. There can be tears in the night but at dawn the golden lining, the pearls and jaspers will appear, not silver because it is too cheap to possess. There will be an “evening light.” Jesus Christ the first and last should be our comfort and hope. He told them “in John 21:6 “cast the net on the right side of the boat, and ye shall find”. Why right side? That is where the Lord of the seas who has foreknowledge of tomorrow and holds you in His hands, knows the site of abundance of fish; the multidollar prosperity that you cannot see but are in store for you. What a mighty God we serve. He knows the site of the treasure house. He will direct us to it. Wait and watch and expect to have it by the little stroke of His indefatigable power and Word of God. There is a right path for you to pass to identify the location for the shoal of fishes to be caught with less toil. If you have lost your bearing, don’t panic; don’t ever think of being disappointed or failed. Ask God for re-Direction. I fumbled with life and had no solid direction. I groped in darkness, no one cares much but when the right season came with all the suffering as a woman, I searched to learn the word of God from AME Zion Church, Assemblies of God and Deeper Life ministries as a visitor then to Bible Believers Fellowship. There I settled for the word of God to cleanse me, be in my heart and that’s what I am eating as a “bitter leaf “for the expectation of the everlasting CROWN”. My as a b..... out of the shave of the fowler. The shave is broken and we are escaped. Our help is In the name of the Lord.

Glory in tribulations

The book of Romans 5:3 teaches us to glory in tribulations

The book of **Romans 5:3**..... teaches us to glory in tribulations. Life does not give man only the desires of his heart. There are two tragedies in life: one is not to get your heart's desire. The other is to get it. So in both tragedies, thank God and glory in His word. Romans 5:3 – 11 says:

V.3 And not only so, but we glory in tribulations also: knowing that tribulation worketh patience;

V.4 And patience, experience; and experience, hope:

V.5 And hope maketh not ashamed; because the love of God is shed abroad in our hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given unto us.

V.6 For when we were yet without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly.

V.7 For scarcely for a righteous man will one die: yet peradventure for a good man some would even dare to die

V.8 But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.

V.9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him.

V.10 For if, when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more being reconciled, we shall be saved by his life.

V.11 And not only so, but we also joy in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, whom we have now received the atonement.

Paul's Tragedy

In II Corinthians 11:25, Paul narrated his ordeal. He was beaten five times, received 40 stripes. Three times he was beaten with rods, once stoned. Thrice had shipwreck; a night and day he was in the deep.

Have we suffered like Paul? Sometimes the weighting may be like it but the bible tells us that the grace of God is sufficient for us.

Don't Quit

Failure/disappointment is nothing. What is really disappointing is for you to quit. Why quit? If the apostles were to quit fishing they would not even have been found on the shore. They hanged

in there probably thinking of the next move of survival and – eventually they survived. Friends, Don't you ever dare quitting that project or study in Mathematics, English or whatever be your interest. Stay there, wait, think of a strategy, work it out, bring in all the applicable principles or get a help. Jesus came to the fishermen's rescue and they survived – that is a bumper harvest. The bible says they couldn't even have managed bringing the fish to shore alone. They called out to other friends. Please I pray you have enough to give to others in need. Bacon them to share your fortune, good news and new ways of doing things to succeed. Serve as a mentor; write it as a recipe or manual. The Lord of host will water and nurture your good intentions and bless you so that you can bless others the more. He will strengthen us and we are bound to have strength from above.

Who shall separate us from the Lord?

In Romans 9:35-37 we read: “Who shall separate us from the Love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril or sword? Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us”.

Are you sure that the devil knows who you are? Let him know now because if you're hot in prayer sincerely and love God and serve him faithfully he will know who you are and will begin to tremble at who you are because you are professing nothing but Jesus Christ from the depths of your heart. Let others say you are a devil just because gates are opening for you. You have found favour with God, they do not know you have a prayer answering God. Instead of asking you of your strategy for success, they give you a name. Jesus was called, “Beelzebub” prince of the devils, (Matthew 12:24) so who are you if you are given a nickname and insults? Even your own household can give you a name, shout at you in order to compensate for a misconduct against you. With no respect displace anger and shout at you. My humble plea is that don't fight at arrows thrown at you Rebuke them, in Jesus' Name. Leave the battle for the Lord.

Expect nothingless

Don't expect anything less than what you have desired. Peter and friends toiled so the caution is that do not be lazy but work hard. Friends, if from today the devil is causing you a condition of peril, sorrow, divorce, separation, rejection, failures and all kinds of disappointments, be bold to tell the devil in the face “I shall not only survive but LIVE in Christ Jesus. I will survive the

crises, and God will make my life grand”. That is why you have to think big and let go, anger, worry or anxiety whilst the weeping lasts for a night, the beams of joy become pronounced at dawn. By morning, the crown of victory is yours, it is just put right on your head. Look on the author of your life. Your Manufacturer sees your needs as the expert and He’d make you survive. May that faithful God be your anchor and make you survive. I shall survive and I have survived. You remember the Shunamite woman who Elisha prayed that God should grant her a child which she had but unfortunately, he died of headache? (II Kings 4:8-26). And she said “it shall be well”. (verse 23) and later changed the sentence “It is well” (verse .26)? Likewise it shall be well with your soul. Then you’d sing within a twinkle of an eye. “It is well – I have survived”. You need to identify yourself as being a champion. Secured under God’s protection. Leave the battle for the Lord and He will fight for us.

The Bible says they overcame the devil by the Blood of the Lamb and by the testimonies of His word (Revelations 12:11). Use the word of God “It is written just as how Jesus Himself used it against the devil and it fled (Luke 4:1-13).

- Apply the correct principles
- Practice extensively what you desire to be your task/project in order to acquire the mastery of relevant skills.
- Call for a help if need be, a mentor or the expert
- Don't quit, have courage to move forward
- Lean on the everlasting arms of God
- Expect nothing less than what you desire – I have survived as a testimony Survivals a key factor – learn to survive by trusting Jesus Christ. Amen.

CHAPTER FIVE

CAST THE STONE FIRST-NO CONDEMNATION

He that is with sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her – John 8:7)

Many times, the unexpected events happen. We tend to marvel but let us be that shunamite woman in II Kings 4:8-37 whose only son complained of illness, and shortly he died. But the woman of faith said in v 23, shall be well and changed her confession, “It is well” II King 4:26.

When peace like a river

It is well, it is well with my soul.

In the last day

I do not know what to say but when Jesus Christ is in the boat no matter the storms, we shall prevail. Children of God will prevail. Events unfolding remind us of the last days as recorded in II Timothy 3:1-5.

V. 1 This know also, that in the last days perilous times shall come.

V. 2 For men shall be lovers of their own selves covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy.

V. 3 Without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, incontinent, fierce despisers of those that are good.

V. 4 Traitors, heady, highminded, lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God;

V. 5 Having a form of godliness, but denying the power thereof: form such turn away.

Shocks will not end. Thunders may stem from your own household, friends, co-workers and form parents or their own families. Nevertheless II Timothy 3:1-5 is reminding us. Sometimes when we read the bible it seems some of the events and warnings sound as stories, never close to happen.

But the Word of God is true. Who will believe that husbands and wives could separate? Some after solemn vows get divorced before the close of one year some after living happily and having issues, no longer seek after the welfare of their children and just bolt away without due thought of the consequences to the growth and development of these innocent ones? Who will also think that children bred with all the care affection with the usual parental hope that these little ones will become adults and expand the family, but to their disappointment the spirit of disobedience, unforgiveness, and terrible displacement of their anger in public places against their parents be possible? But this is what the bible is saying “This know also, that in the last days, perilous times shall come. For men shall be lovers of their own selves, covetous, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy.

Perilous Events at the End

“Peril” means serious danger. Something that cause danger. So when the apostles were in the boat and there was the storm (Matthew 8:23-27). They were having a perilous time. The danger of losing their lives. So was Paul on the sea when the high tides rolled and the goods were cast into the sea to save the situation (Acts 27:1-44). So was the woman with the issue of blood for 12 years (Matthew 9:20).

V. 20 An behold, a woman which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind him, and touched the of his garment.

V. 21 For she said with in herself. If I may, but touch his garment, I shall be whole.

V. 22 But Jesus turned him about and when he saw her, he said “Daughter, be of good comfort, thy faith hath made thee whole”. And the woman was made whole from that hour.

Mark 5:27 records that “When she had heard of Jesus, came in the press behind and touched his garment”

V. 30 Jesus asked“..... who touched my clothes? My friends, the apostles saw the peril. They all were afraid. Psychologically, as the waves were pouring into the ship, they became emotionally disorganized. Ah! Master Jesus too was a sleep after the days preaching and the usual personal interaction, healing and the griefs that He bears with us. In the flesh, yes, He was tired and had every cause to sleep. But His disciples came to Him, and woke Him up saying “Lord, save us; we perish”.

The epistle of Luke 8:24 states, “..... Master, master, we perish”. Then he arose, and rebuked the wind and the raging of the water; and they ceased, and there was calm. The account of the woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years and was bowed together, and could in no wise lift up herself.

She too had a perilous time for this long.

V. 12 And when Jesus saw her, he called her to him, and said unto her, Woman, thou art loosed from thine infirmity.

V. 13 And he laid his hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God.

In John 5:1-9 there was the record of the man who for 38 years had infirmity and was waiting for his turn to get into the pool at Bethesda when the angel of the Lord stirred (troubled) the water but according to the report instead of asking instantly I needed to be made whole when he was asked by Jesus, “Wilt thou be made whole?” this sick man said “Sir, I have no man, when the water is troubled, to put me into the pool; but while I am coming, another steppeth down before me.

V. 8 Jesus s..... unto him, Rise, take up thy bed, and walk.

V. 9 And **immediately** he was **healed** and **walked**.

In these last days we may not necessarily have ship-wreck like Paul who was even promised by the angel of God “Fear not Paul;”. Not only having sickness for 38 years, 12 years and so on, but we are burdened with psychological and psychiatric issues that many people are secretly being tortured and have nobody to talk to. Some people, both young and old are found in the psychiatric homes: Many of whom have their visions buried in their graves. The cemetery is full of potentials. Possible causes are divorce, separation, disobedience of children towards their parents and irresponsibilities of wives, husbands; adult children misbehaving towards their parents and showing gross unthankfulness. Little things cumulated over the years which predisposed many men and women to insanity actually sent them to mental hospitals.

Many parents are now disappointed, likewise sons and daughters. There is no trust and hope only disappointment. People have forgotten good deeds of others and haven't learned to show affection. They can remember nothing good done except to fund harsh words to repay the deeds of good people. II Timothy 3:3 says, These are men without natural affection, trucebreakers, false accusers, men and women and children have become these:

People of God, God is love; He has natural affection for us that's why you and I have unmerited gift the grace. We have done nothing to merit it. Jesus bore our sicknesses and diseases. All the "disgraceful things" we have done, but he became vicarious. He carried my sins and burdens instead He died with our disgraceful behaviours, he had perils, thorns in his flesh, he was beaten and battered spat on, pieced, ridiculed for us. If he did should sons and daughters, conspired to crucify loved ones? Parents, of course those who cared, beloved you, saw you through, can't there be any respect for them. Young people can't you show reciprocal love? This should be natural. You fed on Mama's breast slept on daddy's lap, all affection had been bustled on you till you are independent as you're become adults. Perilous times are looming but adults, parents, do not be carried by the winds.

Look Unto Jesus Christ

The tides are high but no matter what I urge you to look unto Christ the LORD. The disciples in the storm said Master, Carest thou not that we perish? "(Mark 4:38) Master the tempest is raging the billows are tossing high. And Jesus rebuked the storms. Let us have faith.

Faith, faith in the word of God. Let us be aware of these perilous time as recorded in the bible II Timothy 3. Awareness makes you knowledgeable about relevant information and gives you cautions of strategizing to act. We don't have any strategy but the word of God should guide us. We should not also have prejudice since we cannot be sure of anything until we observe for a number of times and that negative behaviour keeps on repeating itself. We should not allow the devil to steal our joy and mar relationship. This is a strategy of the devil to bring divisions to families, friends and brothers and sisters in Christ or of any organized religion. Jesus foreknew his betrayal, death and resurrection. He foreknew Judas Iscariot but by patience, comportment and abundantly grace tolerated him till the end when he fulfilled his wicked mission quickly by selling Jesus for the 30 pieces of silver, not even gold or pearl or jasper but silver and hang himself.

The bible says, let the wicked continue doing wickedly and the good man in righteous living. At the end, the wheat and the tare will be separated.

No Condemnation

Separation, “set apart” for use. Only God knows each one of us whether we shall go to hell or heaven but whether any, I **as an individual must**, and should follow and do the will of God. Formerly, we didn’t know and lived in sin for years. Now we must know and live right God alone can condemn. The woman caught from the adulterous bed was brought to Jesus probably to be condemned. The accusers “set her in the midst” (John 8:3). She became an object of ridicule and they complained “..... master this woman was taken in adultery, in the very act but Jesus did not condemn. He said go and sin no more”. Jesus after listening to their accusations stooped down and with his finger wrote on the ground, as though he didn’t hear them. How many fingers did Jesus use? The report said he used his finger. This probably implies he might have used his index or middle finger. Jesus used his finger. Only one finger. The symbolic representation is this – The remaining fingers are pouring at you the accusers. Jesus said in

V. 7 “..... He that is, without sin among you, let him first cast a stone at her”. Meaning we have all fallen. We are all sinners except Jesus Christ. We have all fallen short of the glory of God. We live because of the grace of God.

All, all, all, things are possible to the believe. We believe that when confess, repent and for sake our sins we put on Christ.

All things are possible to the believer why? Because “..... with God all things are possible (Matthew 20:26). I am saved, new in Christ redeemed by the blood of Jesus. If our hearts do not condemn us we shall make it. If it does let us repent and for sake our sins and iniquities. Let us love those who spitefully use us and say all manner of evil things against us.

Praying for your enemies

The bible says of Jesus’ account (Matthew 5:44-45)

V. 44 But I say unto you, love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

V. 45 That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on unjust.

Introduction

When a Christian dies, it is believed that he/she is asleep in the Lord. “Death” is a physical separation between God and His creation. When we sin, it means we have separated ourselves from our Father who is in heaven and His Kingdom which is in our heart. This means that the spirit of God lives in our heart so when we disobey or sin the spirit leaves us because it is Holy. Hence, if we fornicate, steal, commit adultery, hate our neighbours and refuse to acknowledge Him as God or do anything contrary to His will, we have “death” or experience “death”. If we “Separate” ourselves this way, then we cannot inherit the blessings and promises the donor has

bestowed upon us. We shall be existing and not living. You may have all the riches of this earth but cannot satisfactorily enjoy them. Others may envy you for your wealth but you are not happy. This is a truth, because testimonies reveal this, that in the midst of these riches, a vacuum exists. Why? If you take Christ outside your life, you are merely existing, not living but dead, a “living skeleton” spiritually. A mere existence minus God, our Lord Jesus Christ is death. Solomon in the book of Ecclesiastes, 12:13, reminds us of how to survive on this planet and have good relationship with God the eternal Father; “Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: fear God, and keep his commandments: for this is the whole duty of man”.

V. 14 For God shall bring every work into judgment with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil.

Solomon again reminded the youth as to how to live. He said, in the book of Ecclesiastes 12:1 “Remember now thy Creator in the days of thy youth while the evil days come not, nor the years draw nigh, when thou shall say, I have no pleasure in them;

V. 5 because man goeth to **his long home**, and the mourners go about the streets:

V. 7 Then shall the dust return to the earth as it was: and the spirit shall return unto God who gave it”.

All is vanity

There is nothing new under the sun. Solomon acknowledged this fact in Ecclesiastes or The Preacher 1:9. “that the thing that hath been, it is that which shall be: and that which is done is that which shall be done: and there is no new thing under the sun”.

Solomon married 700 women (Princesses) and 300 concubines, but he declared this act of polygamy as vanity.

Wealth were existing in the ancient times of the biblical days. But the bible says that wealth gotten by vanity shall be diminished: but he that gathereth by labour shall increase (Proverbs 13:11). Abraham, Issac, Israel (Jacob) and Solomon were rich with earthly possessions including servants. In the early days of civilization, history stated it civilization started along the River Nile and Kingdoms sprang with their majestic decorum.

Queen Sheba's Visit

In Solomon's days, we read from I Kings 10:1:13 that the Queen of Sheba visited Solomon because she heard of the fame of Solomon concerning the name of the Lord hence she came to prove him with hard questions.

The bible says "she came to Jerusalem with a very great train, with camels that bare spices, and very much gold, and precious stones; and when she was come to Solomon, she communed with him of all that was in her heart".

V. 3 And Solomon told her all her questions. There was not **anything** hid from the king; which he told her not.

V. 6 And she said to the king, it was a true report that I heard in mine own land of thy acts and of thy wisdom.

V. 7 Howbeit, I believed not the words, until I came, and mine eyes had seen it: and behold the half was not told me: thy wisdom and prosperity exceedeth the fame which I heard.

V. 8 The Queen also saw how happy his servants were and how they served him continually and heard his words of wisdom.

As a token, in V.10 the Queen of Sheba gave Solomon many gifts comprising hundred and twenty talents of gold and of spices in great abundance that no man gave Solomon ever since she also gave him precious stones. She recognized that it was the Lord who bestowed such wealth and joy on Solomon as a chosen king of Israel because the Lord loved Israel forever.

Our Lord is a mighty God, He has all the minerals, silver and gold and all the wealth. He has **all** the powers and all power belongs to Him.

Solomon's Sin

He is that God who does not add curses to His blessings. the bible reports that, "The blessing of the Lord, it maketh rich, and he addeth no sorrow with it" (Proverbs 10:22). Riches and honour, durable ones are with God so is His righteousness.

And here was Solomon blessed with not only riches but wisdom from above. A sign that if God blessed no one can take away. He gives you all that you can use to "stand tall" unto His glory. However, disobedience to His word is death. Solomon married seven hundred wives, princesses and three hundred concubines, and his wives tuned away his heart (1 Kings 11:3). Why was this a

sin? Because God commanded that none of His sons or daughters should contravene the order of going out to marry foreigners since they would turn their hearts unto their gods (Deuteronomy 17:17; I Kings 11:2). He followed their religions, and built high places to offer burnt offerings. Solomon who once loved the Lord and walked in the statute of his father David only sacrificed and burned incense in high places unto God, the most high (1 Kings 3:3). And now Solomon did evil in the sight of the Lord and went not fully after the Lord, as David his father. He built high places for all his strange (foreign) wives and burnt incense and sacrificed unto their gods. And the Lord was angry with him because the women turned his heart away from God (1 Kings 11:8).

The prize for evil doing is death, a separation from the Almighty God.

In Revelation 21:8, the bible states: But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable and murderers, and whore mongers and sorcerers and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone which is the second death.

The White Throne Judgement

We all have to account for our deeds on earth at the throne of Judgement.

John the beloved of Jesus Christ who was thrown on the Island of Patmos, and that's where he had revelations there. Your enemies may push you somewhere that they would think was detestable to them but God can make you live the lions in comfort and grant you "superior" revelations. This was what happened to John. He was abandoned to death but God turned it to a very friendly island for him to inhabit and to have revelations of things to come. In one of his encounters with God, he wrote in Revelations 20:11.

V.11 And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them.

V.12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God: and the books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works.

V.13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it: and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works.

V. 14 And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death.

V.15 And whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.

The bible says we shall find ourselves before the white throne (judgement throne). What preparations are we to make? Sit on the fence? Cleave unto our wealth and be satisfied? Be dignified because of our positions at the job places? Live in hypocrisy, arrogancy, pride and continuously hold unto our own cherished beliefs or sacrifice to the gods and follow traditions or blend traditions with the Christian Religion? Sir, Madam which one? It is written “It is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgement: (Hebrews 9:27, Ecclesiastes 12:5)

Our preparations for the “Long home” must be now. Parents, train your children in the fear of the Lord. Don’t let them loose. Our Lord, our God is one God and His word is truth. Let man be the liar and He be the truth because what He says is what He does. Therefore, we as parents are supposed to diligently teach our children the commandment of the Lord. Write it upon the posts of our house and gates (Deut. 6:7-9). What is wrong with us as parents? We seem to be too busy about our jobs and irrelevant things that we cannot pray and read the bible? Children are great imitators whether good or bad. And that’s why the perfect behaviour, which is acceptable to the Lord Jesus is what we need to model to these young ones. If you need stubborn children, then live the word of God out and misbehave as a parent. If you want them to be drunkards, drug addicts and school drop out or people with low academic achievement, then as a parent exhibit drunkenness and use illicit drugs.

Deuteronomy 14:2 says, We are holy people, unto the Lord our God, chosen and are peculiar people unto him.

Therefore if we want children to be good wives, husbands and community leaders or presidents we should start being loving, careful in the choice of words, train them with acceptable social skills of tolerance, and obedience to rules and regulations of the country and respect authorities. Besides, accommodate other peoples views; believe in dialogue and discussion to resolve misunderstanding. We need to tell them we love them and teach them to reciprocate. Above all, the FEAR OF THE LORD is to be taught them. Being moral is not the ideal because at the end of it all we shall face the White Throne Judgement. Don’t be late. Children are for now – the formative years are the early stages between 0-5 years. If we are late to train them to have the basics of the skills to listen, respect and obey, we are likely to brew trouble for ourselves, the

community and the child as an individual and a citizen. The bible says “Train the child the way he should go: and when he is old, he will not depart from it”. (Proverbs 22:7).

Foolishness is bound in the heart of a child: but the rod of correction shall drive it far from him (Proverbs 22:15). Withhold not correction from the child: for if thou beatest him with the rod, he shall not die. Thou shalt beat him with the rod, and shalt deliver his soul from hell (Proverbs 23:13-14).

You despise the word you shall be destroyed but he that fear the commandment shall be rewarded (Proverbs 13:13).

Warning to children

To children, the bible says in Proverbs 23:22 Hearken unto thy father that begat thee, and despise not thy mother when she is old.

V. 26 My Son give me thine heart and let thine eyes observe my ways.

We as parents are supposed to openly rebuke our children because the bible says so – “Open rebuke is better than secret love (Proverbs 27:5). We need to tell our children “You have not done well in so, so and so. If need be, repeat the rebuke in order to discourage the negative attitude from being repeated next time. Let us train our children in the wisdom of God so that the wise Son can make the father glad. The bible says “A wise son maketh a glad father: but a foolish son is the heaviness of his mother (Proverbs 10:1).

If you ever had a foolish son, then your heart will grieve with pain and sorrow. Some of our children seem to be good outside but terrible in the home especially where a father is absent through divorce, separation or death. That child can be a hero, and hailed outside by friends and the community but yet he has a heinous character. I believe we all need to pray for our children right now even as they are old. Remember, the white throne judgement is at hand. Let us tell God we have done our best even at the last hour. At least the angels are writing our experiences and our own records will bear testimonies of all our lives.

Where we are becoming too much depressed and life seems unbearable as if, we want to be out of our bodies in order to feel better, let us simply ask for Abundant Grace, from the Lord. The journey is not all that smooth. The terrain is ruddy but it takes the feebleness of the mind and

hands to stretch to God and say “This is enough, Lord we need a break through”. Let us learn to cry like Moses. Lift up our heart unto Him, speak the word, remind Him of His promises concerning the situation and He will hear.

The last mile prayer

I pray that the Grace of God abide with you. It is a time of agony, torment, but we shall survive. Let us gather momentum to make the last step, a step of success. No matter the terrain, we shall survive, we shall sing the song that the angels do not know. We shall meet the Lord face to face but again it takes a hard work to make it. Let the BIBLE be our guide, our solace and eternal hope for eternal victory. Victory is ours for the cross has a *CROWN and that's the ultimate on the Road to Calvary, the last Bus Stop on the last mile*. Let us have courage like Joshua, meekness like Moses; Perseverance like Caleb and Joshua, prayerfulness like Daniel and Simeon waiting and fasting like Esther and Anna: Praising and dancing like Miriam and David. These are all bible characters who had played their roles and left foot prints for us.

May the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob (Israel) Our God, help us on the last mile to the LAST BUS STOP of life's journey.

Remember that your identity as the child of God is not by magical design. But before the foundation of the world you were a chosen vessel, a peculiar (unique) nation, the blessed of the Lord. Just be faithful and God will see you through.

So just be faithful and Believe his word.
